

#### The Creation of a new GPC website:

The Outreach Committee of our church began the labor some work for creating a new church website more than 18 months ago. The primary goal was to create an outward looking site that will become the primary information conduit for all those looking for information about our church.

Research shows that church websites are frequently the first point of contact for new community members who looking for a church home. The Outreach Committee gave thought to the information on our site, believing that its helps describe and illustrate the warmth and friendliness of our Christian ministry in Greencastle.

Quality websites require creative, technical expertise. As with many things in life, you get what you pay for. We are blessed to have had an anonymous member in our congregation generously pay for the creation of our new site. Moving forward, the church will have an annual line item in its budget covering website security and the annual use of an exclusive domain name which will be our new web address.

The new address for our site will be: www.visitgpcpa.org

It is scheduled to be live on the internet by September 1, 2023.

In the coming weeks, the Outreach Committee will be editing, tweaking and fine tuning the information on the site.

Significant site features include a newly imaged church logo, a secure online giving platform, a password protected membership directory, pictures of our church staff & leadership and information about church history, membership, Christian Education and Missions.

There will be ongoing scrutiny to pictures used on the site.

- The faces of minor children will not be shown on the site.

In the coming weeks, the Outreach Committee will be providing more information about the Website and its secure online giving platform.
