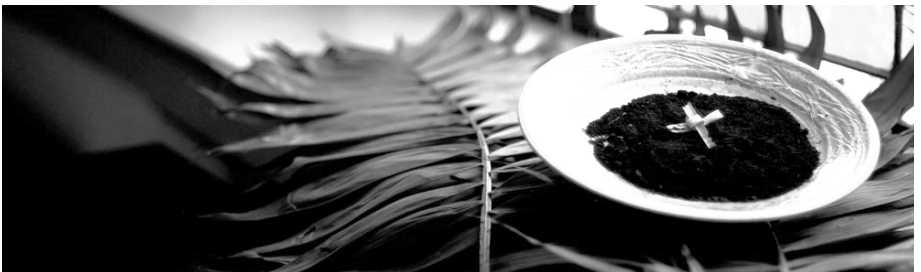

Ash Wednesday (February 18th) begins the penitential season of Lent. The liturgical season offers us an opportunity to practice our spiritual practices with increased attention and as a way of making the Easter season that follows so much more joyful and fulfilling.



We will continue the practice of offering **Ashes-To-Go to anyone beginning at 12 noon** – regardless of the weather. We will have an **Ash Wednesday Worship Service at 7 pm** in the sanctuary.

To wear the mark of ashes is to say we humbly offer ourselves to God knowing our mortality our desire to turn from sin. People are marked with the symbol of the cross, which symbolizes the love of God in Christ to our world and hope that all Christians have of new life in Jesus. We hope you will make it a point to come to the evening service. And if you are passing the church at noon on Ash Wednesday, stop by for the imposition of Ashes. It is a blessing to you and a public witness of your faith in Jesus.
