All: We come to the table not just as individuals but as a community. By sharing the loaf and the cup, Christ makes us one with him and with each other.

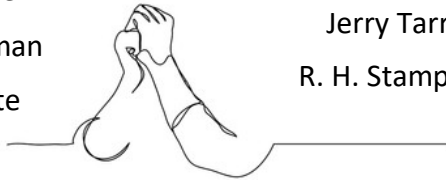
Pastor: With joy we praise you, gracious O God, for you have created heaven and earth, made us in your image, and kept covenant with us— even when we fell into sin.

Becoming a Member at GPC

The membership statement of the Presbyterian Church (USA) reads: ***“Membership in the Church of Jesus Christ is a joy and a privilege. It is also a commitment to participate in Christ’s mission.
